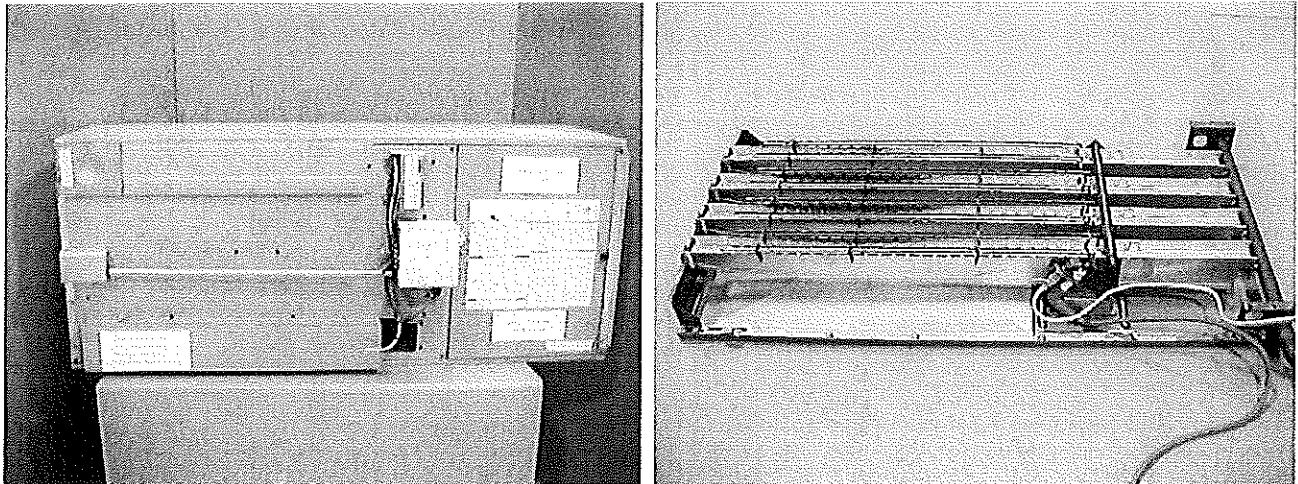


MODEL NUMBER LIST FOR CONSOLIDATED "NOx ROD FURNACE" RECALL

1.0 FURNACES SUBJECT TO RECALL

Several models of horizontal furnaces manufactured by Consolidated Industries, Inc. are subject to recall because of potential fire hazards associated with the burner design. The furnaces were sold under various brand names, which are listed in the table below.

They are gas-fired horizontal furnaces equipped with steel "NOx rods" installed above the burners. They are commonly called "NOx rod furnaces." Any such furnace identified during NGAT Testing must be reported to CIP for check by a GSR.



These gas-fired horizontal furnaces have steel rods (right) installed above the burners.

- a. **“NOx rod furnaces” usually have an X at the end of the model number, either the last character or the next-to-last character.** Exceptions include Trane and Bard, as shown by the examples in column 3 above.
- b. These furnaces were manufactured from the 08th week of 1983 (date code “8308”) through the 52nd week of 1994 (date code “9452”). **The date code *may* be found in the *first four characters* of the serial number, which will range from 8308 through 9452.**
- c. As shown in the table, the serial number of a “NOx rod furnace” may *not* include an X or a 4-digit date code. However, the serial number *will* contain the lettering or numbering designations listed in the table.
- d. In summary, for each horizontal furnace, check the nameplate for any of the following:
 - A Company Name or Trade Name listed in the table.
 - Date of manufacture from 1983 thru 1994 (and/or a date code as described in b. above).
 - A model number containing the lettering or numbering designations listed in the table.

3.0 NGAT PROCEDURE

1. Check each horizontal furnace to determine whether the model number on the nameplate is one listed above.
2. Report the furnace to CIP for check by a GSR (and possible R&R if owner-occupied) when:
 - The furnace is on the recall list, or
 - The model number cannot be determined (e.g., missing or illegible nameplate).

Rinnai Recalls Wall Furnaces Due to Carbon Monoxide Hazard

WASHINGTON, D.C. - The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission, in cooperation with the firm named below, today announced a voluntary recall of the following consumer product. Consumers should stop using recalled products immediately unless otherwise instructed.

Name of Product: Direct-Vent Wall Furnaces, Models RHFE 431 and RHFE 556

Units: About 52,000

Manufacturer: Rinnai America Corp., of Peachtree City, Ga.

Hazard: A gasket in the unit can fail, posing a risk of poisonous carbon monoxide gas leaking into the home.

Incidents/Injuries: Rinnai has received 11 reports of carbon monoxide leaking from the furnace. No injuries have been reported.

Description: The recall involves Rinnai EnergySaver Direct-Vent Wall Furnaces, Models RHFE 431 and RHFE 556. They are either natural gas or LP gas (propane) fueled. The following model numbers are included in the recall:

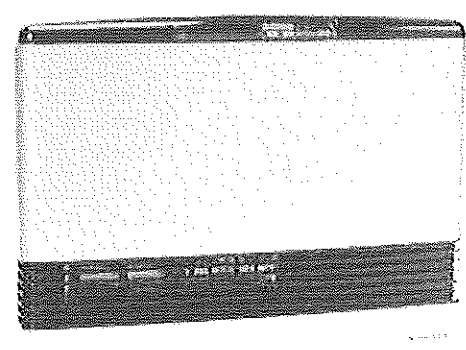
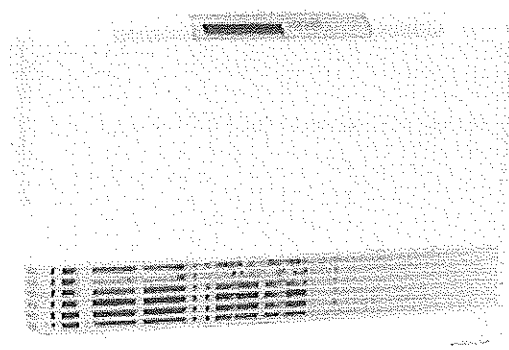
The model number is printed on the top of the rating plate located on the right side of the unit. The recall includes only those units manufactured from February 2000 through December 2007. The manufacturing date code is the first four digits of the serial number, written as YY MM, and is located at the bottom of the rating plate.

Sold through: Wholesale distributors nationwide to contractors and dealers from February 2000 through December 2007 for between \$1,600 and \$1,900.

Manufactured in: Japan

Remedy: Consumers should stop using the furnace immediately and contact the firm to arrange for the installation of a free repair kit.

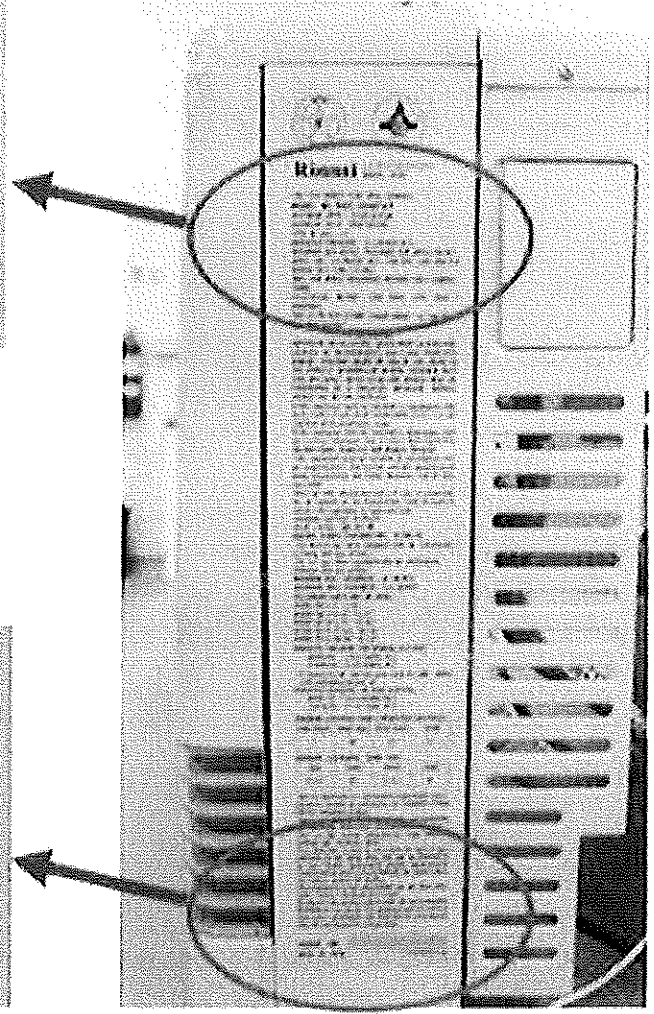
