



This fact sheet provides details for enrolling in Pacific Gas & Electric Company's Whole House Rebate Program under Energy Upgrade California.

1.	Visit www.builditgreenutility.org .
2.	<p>Click on either Contractor or Rater Enrollment icon (circled in red below).</p>  <p>This will take you to the online the corresponding Enrollment/Account Management site.</p>
3.	<p>Enter your user name and password (as New User if it's a first visit; Returning Member otherwise).</p>  <p>Thank you for your interest in applying to become an Energy Upgrade California Participating Contractor in the Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) service territory. By submitting your application, you are agreeing to the terms and conditions contained in the documents below.</p>

4.	Enter your enrollment application information
5.	Enter insurance information and upload copies of certificates for general liability, bonding, automobile liability (if applicable), and workers compensation insurance (if applicable)
6.	Enter contractor's license and/or professional certifications (upload copies of BPI and/or HERS ID cards) and/or staff information
7.	Download and review the five Program documents referenced in the Participation Agreement: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Terms and Conditions b. Whole House Combustion Appliance Safety Test Procedure c. Participant Handbook d. PG&E's Energy Upgrade California (EUC) Program Guidelines for Customer Collateral e. Contractors: Co-Brand with Energy Upgrade California
8.	Check off the boxes indicating that you have reviewed the relevant documents and scan, then upload a signed Participation Agreement and submit application.
